Curriculum Timeline 2018-2019



- Identify prioritized standards for content areas with teacher design teams.
 - ELA, MAth, Science, Social Studies, Visual Arts, Music, PE, Computer Science, Drama and Theatre
- Created proficiency scales for content areas with teacher design teams.
- Gathered feedback from teachers involved with teacher writing teams
- Drafted initial implementation
- Began communication plan.
 - Shared draft plans with key leaders.
- Begin to **educate the Board of Education** (BOE) about the nature of the curriculum work and the timeline
- Began to offer learning opportunities about the topic of standards-based learning
 - Principal learning, Deeper Learning Days, Monday PL
- Began to develop where to house proficiency scales for teachers to access in the Bridge to Curriculum

Curriculum Timeline 2019-2020



- Continued to create proficiency scales for content areas with teacher design teams.
- Developed a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) document and Blog based upon responses from teacher design teams.
- Begin field-testing prioritized standards and proficiency scales with students.
- Gathered electronic feedback teachers
- Began to align quality classroom assessments with prioritized standards and proficiency scales for some content areas
- Continued to provide learning opportunities for our educators across the system
- **Presented to the board of education** (BOE) and **Teacher Advisory Committee** (TAC) to update about the progress of the work around proficiency scales
- Continued **work with with IT for** electronic storing and access of prioritized standards, proficiency scales, and classroom assessments.





Curriculum Timeline 2020-2021

- Phase 3 Announce implementation and share written implementation plans with all staff
- Align **quality classroom assessments** with prioritized standards and proficiency scales for content areas using teacher design teams.
- Obtain feedback and refine the prioritized standards and proficiency scales, as design team teachers begin trying them with students.
- Teacher design teams **review feedback** on prioritized standards and proficiency scales, revise, and respond as necessary.
- Continue to **train staff in assessment literacy practices** around validity, reliability, and fairness
- Continued work with teachers of exceptional students for adjusting proficiency scales for SPED, EL, and GT.
- **Assemble** a standards-based learning (SBL) grading team.
- Continue to educate and update the board of education (BOE) and other stakeholder groups
- Provide teachers with tools and supports to use proficiency scales for core content areas with students.
- Provide communication to students and families regarding proficiency scales and the Jeffco curriculum (e.g.) student-friendly scales, translations, curriculum framework, feedback loop, include in the DAC DUIP committee work). Curriculum Timeline 2021-2022

- Continue **revising proficiency scales**, as beginning implementation efforts with classroom assessments.
- Continue to **train staff in assessment literacy practices** around validity, reliability, and fairness
- Continued **work with teachers of exceptional students** for adjusting proficiency scales for SPED, EL, and GT.
- Implement a standards-based learning (SBL) grading system in elementary.
- Continue to update the board of education (BOE) and other stakeholders
- Continue to partner with **teachers to gather tools and supports** to use proficiency scales with students.
